

CLINIC INSTRUCTIONS

- Appointments are not necessary but check in is 7:00-9:00 AM on Sunday Spay Days and 10:00-11:00 AM on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday.
- Boarding is not available for feral cats except in unusual circumstances involving an injury.

Attach a cage slip to each cage detailing instructions for the vet. Cage slips available at clinic.

- You will receive a medical record for each cat. It is VERY IMPORTANT to keep your records. It is proof to Animal Control that your cats have been sterilized and vaccinated if you need to prove this.

If a cat has been injured, please include this information on the cage slip. Dr. Thronburgh will determine if it is treatable or if the cat should be euthanized. There may be an extra charge for treatment.

- If you request a FeLV/FIV test, be prepared for a positive result and be committed to your decision whether or not to euthanize. Plan ahead and talk to a contact person beforehand. Information concerning these viruses is available from Alley Cat Allies-www.alleycat.org
